### World Youth Day – Bus to Randwick

The climax of WYD is the closing Mass, which will be celebrated by Pope Benedict at Randwick Racecourse on Sunday, 20<sup>th</sup> July. We are hoping to organise one (or more!) buses to transport those of you who would like to attend this Mass to and from Randwick. This would include homestay hosts (who receive a complimentary ticket to the Mass), and registered WYD pilgrims (who have paid the \$175 weekend or \$335 week-long registration fee) who chose not to sleep at Randwick on Saturday night. Both of these groups are guaranteed a seat inside the racecourse. All others are also welcome to come along, however if the racecourse is full, you may end up sitting in neighbouring Centennial Park, where there will be large screens telecasting the Mass. It will be about \$20 per person / \$50 family for the bus. It will drop us off as close as possible, but there may still be a 10 minute or so walk to our seating. If you would like to come on our parish bus, please put your name down on the sheet at the back of the church asap, so we know how many buses to book!
